- 1. Who can participate? The Clay Paver Award Vande Moortel is for all kind of projects designed and/or created by professionals with clay pavers of Brickworks Vande Moortel executed after January 2015.
- 2. How to take part? Send your design, a brief statement and some pictures supporting your entry to news@vandemoortel.be. To support your entry, you can tweet, pin or Instagram with #claypaverawards2018.
- 3. When is the deadline to send projects? The entries close at the end of April 2019.
- 4. What are the distinct categories?
 - Small projects: for private projects, smaller than 250 m² using clay pavers
 - Medium and large projects: for private projects, bigger than 250 m² using clay pavers
 - Contemporary projects: for all modern and contemporary designs using clay pavers.
 - Public and publicly accessible projects: for all public or publicly accessible projects using clay pavers
- 5. De winner of each category will receive:
 - A unique personalised award
 - A city break for two to Ghent. Two nights' accommodation in the historic centre and dinner at a top restaurant in Ghent.
 - A professional photo reportage of the winning project by a top photographer.

All entries will be given the attention that they deserve.

- 7. A panel of international leading landscape design connoisseurs will pick a winner out of each category.
